Kids Striped Hat & Mittens

mittens worked in the round afterthought thumb

materials & gauge:

needed:

hat: 3.75 (US 5) double point or circular needles worsted weight yarn

MC: 200 yards, CC: 15 yards (larger size)

mittens: 3.75 (US 5) double point or circular needles worsted weight yarn MC: 160 yards, CC: 10 yards (larger size)

gauge:2" = 10 st/14 r in stockinette

all yarn requirements are approximate

medium: 20" hat circumference, 6 1/2" hand circumference (around knuckles) large: 21" hat circumference, 7" hand circumference (around knuckles) adjustments for larger size in ()



hat instructions:

With MC cast on 84 (90) sts and split evenly among needles, being careful not to twist.

ribbing:

 * *k2, p1 around

repeat for 2 inches, or until desired length. crown:

* 5 rnds: k around.

with CC. k around.

repeat these steps until hat is 6" (7") from cast on edge.

decreases (worked in MC):

1: *k12 (13), k2tog repeat from * to end 2: *k11 (12), k2tog repeat from * to end continue in progressing, working one less st between decreases each rnd, until 12 sts remain.

finishing:

cut 6" tail and thread through loops. pull tight and clip. pull tail to inside. weave in all ends and clip.

p: purl

rnd(s): rounds

st(s): stitch(es)

techniques & abbreviations:

CC: contrasting color MC: main color k: knit k2tog: knit 2 stitches together as one

mitten instructions:

with MC, cast on 30 (33) sts and split evenly among needles, being careful not to twist.

- work around in k2, p1 ribbing until cuff is 2¼" (2½") or to desired length.
- k around, increasing 6 (7) sts evenly. (36, 40 sts)

lower hand:

- 5 rnds: k around
- * with CC, k around.

repeat these steps until mitten is $1\frac{3}{4}$ " ($2\frac{4}{4}$ ") from ribbing, or until you reach base of thumb.

thumb placement:

- k2. with a length of waste varn, k6 (7) for thumb opening.
- slip waste yarn sts back to LH needle and knit to end of round with working yarn.

upper hand:

continuing in established color and st pattern, knit around until mitten measures 3%" from waste yarn, or about 1%" from desired length.

decreases:

- ** k7 (8), k2tog. Repeat from * around. 32/36 sts
- * *k6 (7), k2tog. Repeat from * around. 28/32 sts

continue as established, working one less stitch between decreases and working a CC rnd every 6th rnd, until 12 sts remain.

- clip yarn, leaving a 12" tail. draw through remaining loops, pulling tightly to close.
- tie off and pull tail to inside. weave in end securely.

thumb:

- pick out waste yarn at thumb. working from left to right, place live sts on 2 needles. (5, 6) sts on top/(6, 7) sts on bottom.
- place marker to identify beginning of rnd. pick up one stitch in the corner (be sure to twist so a gap does not form), then k across bottom sts with MC.
- pick up one stitch in the corner, making sure to twist. k across upper sts. 13 (15) sts
- \star join and k around until thumb is 2" (2¼") or
- ¼″ less than desired length. ★ k2tog around.
- clip yarn, leaving a 12" tail. draw through remaining loops, pulling tightly to close.
- tie off and pull tail to inside. weave in end securely.

repeat for 2nd mitten!

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
